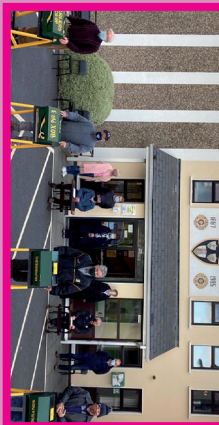

Happy Days. We are back again. Last year, 2020, we tried to adapt to the situation and still keep some normality about everything. This was very welcomed and appreciated by both the clubs and you the supporters. I would like to thank you all for your consideration and help in making 2020 successful for all the clubs.

Now its 2021 and we can start being hopeful again and look forward. We are bringing the Hurlers Co-Op back to its original format but with an increase in prize money (now €115,000) and all cash prizes. There are choices of cars however to add an extra incentive, a choice in the 1st, 3rd and 5th draws.

The Hurler's Co-Op Draw has been held annually since 1982. It contributes to the development of GAA clubs and plays an important part in the fundraising schedule of every club involved. It has almost become a way of life for many of us.

It's people that have made this draw successful. Those playing and working at club level. Those supporting the efforts of teams, trainers and club officials. It takes a big team to keep the show on the road whether it's your local club or the Hurlers Co-Op Draw. People working together are powerful.

Time, effort, dedication, hard work and support are necessary to return sales annually of 9,000 tickets. This combination results in a very positive financial return to your club and there is no risk involved.

These funds are necessary to maintain and improve the level of facilities within the clubs, to support the training and education of players of all ages and to continue the development of UPMC Nowlan Park, the centre of Kilkenny GAA.

Our prize fund is 2021 is in excess of €115,000. The cost of ticket is still €50 for 5 draws. A **minimum** of 50% is earned by each club for every ticket they sell. When you buy a ticket in this 'value-for-money' draw, you are supporting your local community and county.

The more tickets a club sells the higher their income.

Please support your club again in 2021 and contribute to the development of your community and county.
