All Ireland Hurling Championship Final 2022

So it's the Cats and the Treaty men that remain to battle it out for Liam McCarthy in addition to the eagerly sought after bragging rights. TJ Reid gave a man of the match performance in the semi-final with stellar performances by a host of teammates. Mikey Butler stood out for his superb marking of Tony Kelly. Brian Cody described the semi-final win over Clare as "a very very good win for sure".

With the All-Ireland final set for Croke Park next Sunday (July 17th at 3.30pm) this will be the first meeting of Kilkenny and Limerick in the final since 2007.

The counties have met in nine previous senior hurling finals, Kilkenny winning five (1911, 1933, 1935, 1974 and 2007) and Limerick four (1897, 1936, 1940 and 1973). The game will finish on the day so extra time and penalties are possibilities.

All-Ireland Hurling Final Tickets - Application & Distribution

Paid up club members were invited to submit their application for an All-Ireland hurling final ticket (1 ticket per member) with the entries deadline set at 5pm on Sunday (July 10th 2022).

Pending receipt of allocation, tickets are expected to include a range across all stands and terraces with no concessions for this fixture i.e. no Student/OAP tickets. To improve administration, tickets will be drawn under supervision of the committee on Thursday 14th July at 19:30 in the Academy Hotel.

Members must be present on the night (or have a named nominee assigned to represent them) to be eligible for inclusion in the draw. In the event of non-collection on the night, a reserve list will be used for those who do not secure a ticket in original draw.

All ticket payments must be settled on the night with a preference for cashless transactions such as cheque or Revolut.

Colm Lyons has been confirmed as the man with the whistle for this year's Senior Hurling Final. He is from Cork and a member of the Nemo Rangers Club.

Although this will be his first Senior Hurling Final, Colm Lyons has previously refereed an All-Ireland Minor Hurling Final in 2012, a National Hurling League Final in 2017, a Leinster Hurling Final in 2017 and on two occasions, the All-Ireland Senior Club Hurling Final, in 2018 and also in 2020, when Ballyhale Shamrocks retained their title.

In this year's Leinster Championship, Colm Lyons refereed Kilkenny v Galway and two Munster championship games between Limerick v Clare & the All Ireland Quarter Final between Wexford v Clare. Colm also refereed National league matches between Wexford v Clare and Tipperary v Waterford.

The other match officials are as follows:- Stand by referee: Liam Gordon (Galway), Linesman: Paud O Dwyer (Carlow), Sideline: Michael Kennedy (Tipperary) and Umpires on the day will all be from Cork clubs :- Ciarán Hanley (Brian Dillons) and Johnny Barry (Ballinure), Philip Mackey and Finian Mullane (Nemo Rangers).

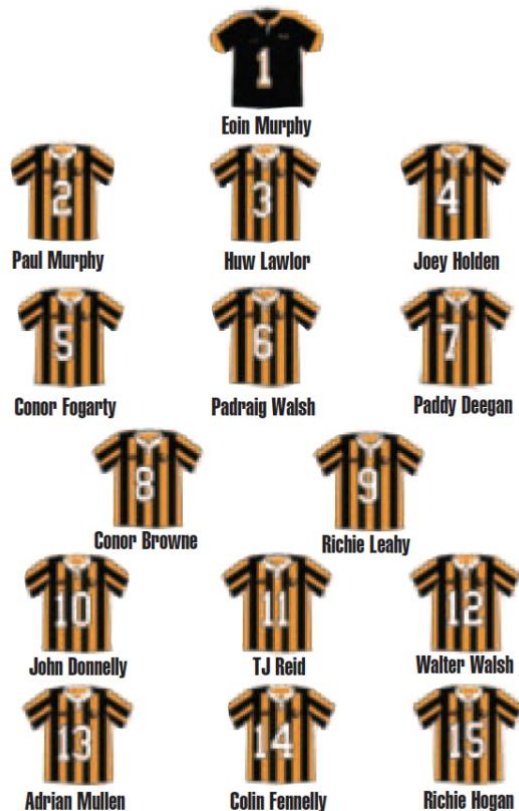

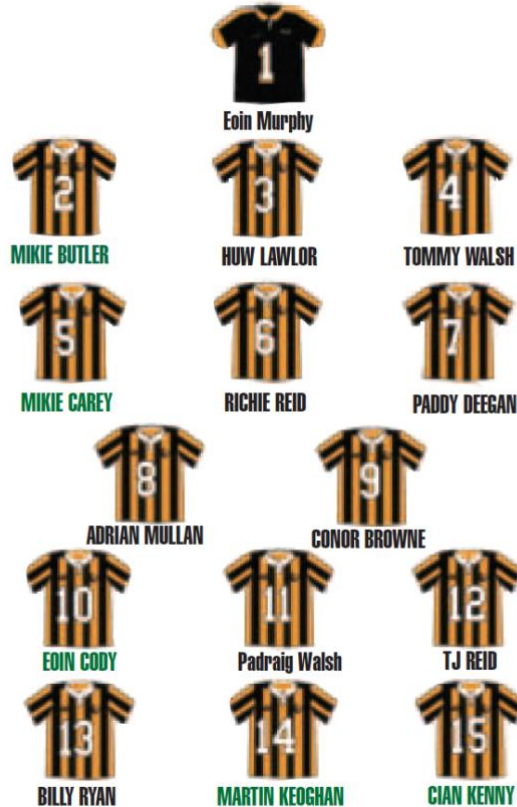
